## **CoreMMIS Implementation Date**

February 6, 2017

On January 30, 2017, Indiana's Family and Social Services Administration ("FSSA") published Bulletin BT201710 announcing that the Indiana Health Coverage Programs ("IHCP") have set **Monday, February 13, 2017**, as the new implementation date for replacing the current information system, Indiana*AIM*, with *Core*MMIS. *Core*MMIS stands for Core Medicaid Management Information System, the state's new Medicaid interface for providers. With *Core*MMIS' implementation, a new interface called the Provider Healthcare Portal ("Portal") will replace Web interChange.

All providers should register a single *Provider* account as well as all needed *Delegate* accounts on the Portal for every service location enrolled with IHCP. All Portal accounts should be established before *Core*MMIS' implementation to avoid interruptions in business transactions. Providers can register for the Portal here. The first Remittance Advice from *Core*MMIS will be released on Monday, February 20, 2017, with a paid date of Wednesday, February 22, 2017.
