Uphold Fiscal Responsibility, Streamline Government

- Pass an honestly balanced, two-year state budget that maintains critical investments in education and infrastructure while protecting taxpayers (HB 1001)
- Reduce regulations on K-12 schools to increase flexibility, focus on outcomes and give local communities more control over education decisions (HB 1002)





Reduce Costs, Improve Services

- Improve transparency and predictability in health care pricing and billing, and provide patients increased access to their health information and more control over their treatment options (HB 1003)
- Ensure nonprofit hospitals act as nonprofit entities focused on delivering health care (HB 1004)
- Meet the needs of today's energy economy while reducing costs for Hoosiers by maintaining and growing our generating capacity, including embracing small modular nuclear reactors (SMRs) (HB 1007)





Strengthen, Grow our Low-Cost, Low-Tax Hoosier Communities

- Strengthen public safety by providing additional state investment for deputy prosecutors (HB 1006)
- Improve access to housing by expanding the Residential Housing
 Infrastructure Assistance Program (RIF) to help Hoosier communities finance
 infrastructure projects that support residential housing (HB 1005)
- Create the Indiana-Illinois Boundary Adjustment Commission to embrace neighboring counties that want to join low-tax, low-cost Indiana, including the 33 counties in Illinois that have voted since 2020 (seven in the November 2024 election) to secede from their high-tax state (HB 1008)
